RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that your Board: ratify, approve and authorize the Health Care Agency Director to enter into an Agreement with Catalyst Technologies, Inc. to provide data processing services to the Ventura County Health Care Plan in conjunction with its participation in the annual health plan quality of care measurement program conducted by the National Committee on Quality Assurance (NCQA); such Agreement with Catalyst Technologies, Inc., is for services in an amount not to exceed \$174,000 for the period January 1, 2009 through November 30, 2011.

REASON FOR RATIFICATION:

This contract was originally signed March 2009 under the deputized purchasing authority granted to the HCA Director. Initially, it was interpreted that since the cost in any one year of this Agreement was less than \$100,000, Board approval was not necessary.

When the VCHCP sought to make payment to the vendor, it was brought to our attention that County policy requires that any service agreement with a cost in excess of \$100,000 during the "initial term" of the agreement must be approved by the Board of Supervisors.

DISCUSSION:

The Ventura County Health Care Plan (VCHCP) participates in the "National Committee for Quality Assurance's" (NCQA) annual quality of care measurement process known as the "Healthcare Effectiveness Data and Information Set" (HEDIS) program. NCQA is a private, not-for-profit organization dedicated to improving health care quality and recognized and respected industry-wide.

The HEDIS program requires that VCHCP provide patient claims and medical record data to an NCQA-certified vendor, such as Catalyst Technologies, who sorts through the data using sophisticated software programs to gather the appropriate patient care information for electronic submission to NCQA.

VCHCP is required under its contract with the State agency known as the "Managed Risk Medical Insurance Board" (MRMIB) to submit this patient care data for members enrolled in the State's "Healthy Families Program".

IT Services reviewed the request and, from this review, has no concerns on (1) its technology, (2) how it would be implemented in the County or (3) that it would have a detrimental impact on any existing common County infrastructure.
