

RESOLUTION OF THE VENTURA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
EXTENDING THE PROCLAMATION OF A LOCAL EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property within the County of Ventura have arisen by virtue of H1N1 Swine Flu pandemic and, at which time the Board of Supervisors of Ventura County was not in session and said conditions constitute a local emergency as defined in Government Code Section 8558, subdivision (c); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the powers granted by virtue of Section 5323-1 of the Ventura County Ordinance Code, as amended, for occasions when the Board of Supervisors is not in session, the Sheriff of Ventura County, as Director of Disaster Services, proclaimed the existence of a local emergency on the 20th day of October 2009, which proclamation is subject to ratification by the Board of Supervisors by a four-fifths vote at its next meeting within seven days thereafter; and

WHEREAS, Board of Supervisors Resolution dated March 2, 1993 further delegates to the Sheriff the authority to declare a local emergency, pursuant to Section 22035 of the Public Contract code, on behalf of Special Districts governed by the Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors does hereby find that the aforesaid continuing conditions of extreme peril did warrant and necessitate the proclamation of the existence of a local emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors, on behalf of the County of Ventura and Special Districts they govern, extend the local emergency proclamation ratified by your Board on October 27, 2009, and which finds and proclaims a state of local emergency which shall be deemed to exist until termination of the local emergency is proclaimed by the Board of Supervisors. Said proclamation shall be reviewed at least every fourteen (14) days by the Board of Supervisors to determine the need for continuing the local emergency.

Upon motion of Supervisor _____, seconded by Supervisor _____, the foregoing resolution was passed and adopted on December 8, 2009.
