I strongly urge Ventura County to follow the lead of Los Angeles and other CA counties to adopt a No Transfers Policy and cease any kind of coordination with ICE, including indirect assistance, such as the public posting of release dates from County jail. The wrong has been righted in our local justice system, and that person - a father, mother, son, daughter, grandparent, needs to return to their family, their job, their loved ones who depend on them, not be swept away and have their family torn apart.

In the cities of Fillmore, Santa Paula, in Piru and across our County, which has cities, including Fillmore, that are some of the safest in our State, thousands of families - our families, our neighbors, our children's friends and classmates, people, good hard-working people who literally make our County run and make our lives easier and more comfortable, are living in fear and experiencing ongoing, chronic trauma for fear of deportation of family members. Please consider this, and please stop all transfers. Please stop aiding to breaking apart families in this County.
