Subject: Recommendation to Appoint Margaret Kestly to the Ventura County Climate Emergency Council Representing Supervisorial District Number 4

Recommendation:

It is recommended that your Board appoint Margaret Kestly to the Ventura County Climate Emergency Council representing Supervisorial District Number 4.

Discussion:

On October 20, 2020, your Board adopted Resolution No. 20-124 establishing the Ventura County Climate Emergency Council (VCCEC) and its bylaws, which address its membership, operation, and management. Each of the five supervisors are to nominate one person residing in their respective district for appointment to the VCCEC by your Board.

Supervisor Huber has nominated and recommends that your Board appoint Margaret (Maggie) Kestly as the District 4 representative to the VCCEC. Ms. Kestly is a resident of Simi Valley and the president of CSMC Management, Inc., doing business as Mid Valley Properties. During her 35 years in the industry, Ms. Kestly has actively been involved in the community on many different levels including serving on the General Plan Advisory Committee and the Permit Processing Committee. She served two years as the District 4 Ventura County Planning Commissioner where she had the opportunity to fully learn and understand issues such as climate change.
