I object to the adoption of the proposed ordinance:

- The proposal does not limit the length of time a permittee is issued a permit;
- The proposal does not limit the number of permits issued [see 7253(c)(4)];
- The proposal does not have any accountability for permittees to clean their area before they move, thereby enabling them to leave trash and waste behind. For example, is the area designated to a particular permittee numbered? If so, is this updated every 72 hours when they move? If not, how do we know whose trash is left in the street. Currently, the RV's, trailers and the box truck move around and leave trash behind. I have pictures of plies of trash in areas where RV's were once parked but where there is currently no RV. No one is taking responsibility for the piles of trash, including the overflowing trash can next to the rarely used bus stop.
- The plan does not share the burden with other parts of the county.

I also object to the finding that the adoption of the ordinance is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act and an appeal to this finding will be filed with the appropriate state agencies.
