Dear Supervisor -

I am a homeowner in District One and am very concerned about the RV/Overnight Camping that has grown over the past four years. I believe it is terrible for our community, terrible for home values, terrible for our environment, and I would like you to stop it. Supervisor Bennett's recent plan does not address all of the concerns of our community, and I respectfully request that you postpone adoption of the plan.

This practice has had a very serious impact on the quality of life I experience and we really need to do better than what Supervisor Bennett has proposed. A new Supervisor for District One is coming in (in a few weeks) and us residents feel it is best to wait for him to take office before a plan is introduced. He can hear our concerns and make some modifications that will be more suitable for our neighborhood. Supervisor Bennett has had four years to deal with this problem, but he simply ignored it and allowed it to actual worsen. Put simply, he has failed, and there is no reason for him to ram it through in his last month of office.
