Dear Supervisors

My family and I have lived in District One for 17 years.

We are very concerned about the RV Camping that has grown over the past 4 years. I believe it is Terrible for our community and would like you to find a better solution for it than the one you are proposing today. Supervisor Bennett's recent plan does not address all of the concerns of our community and I respectfully request that you postpone adopting the plan at this time.

I can appreciate Supervisor Bennett's desire to complete a "task" by being able to check the box on fixing this "issue" Pushing through his plan without addressing all the concerns is foolhardy. It has been said that when the "COVID crisis is over in 1 yr" this will end. What if COVID becomes a seasonal issue like the flu, what if those "living homeless" because not everyone is out there because of mental health issues, a lost job or recent evictions decide this is preferable to paying rents and mortgages. What then? How many permits, will spaces be marked off, can people erect tents, will there be security patrols (we've already felt an increase in crime), how will sanitation / trash be handled.

A new Supervisor for District One is coming in a few weeks and we feel it is best to wait for them to get into office before a plan is voted on and possibly put in place as they will be able to hear our concerns. They will be able to participate in making modification with actual numbers that are enforceable regarding "how many can be parked and for how long they can stay", sanitation, repairing and clean up of damage already being done.

Supervisor Bennett has had 4 years to deal with this problem - it is unacceptable for him to force something that has too many unanswered questions and also too many potential loop holes.
