Dear Supervisors,

We are writing **in support** of the proposal to amend the coastal and non-coastal zoning ordinances to require additional review and approvals for conditional use permits.

As (inadvertent) owners of mineral rights shares of California Resources Corporation, we've been asked to tell you that you should vote no on this proposal because it will be a threat to the income we receive from this investment.

We recognize that this is so much bigger than any concern for the viability of this organization and its shareholders, including ourselves.

More than 8,000 Ventura County residents live within 2,500 feet of an oil well and 60% of them are Latinx. Across the state, the vast majority of Californians who live in close proximity to oil drilling are from communities of color, already severely overburdened with other forms of pollution- from ports, freeways, oil refineries, and other industrial polluters.

Your vote will send a clear message that our elections here in Ventura County can't be bought and that this Board will always be focused on adequately and *equally* protecting all of its citizens.
