**SUBJECT: RESOLUTION RESTRICTING PARKING ON MAIN STREET
PIRU AREA
SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICT NO. 3**

RECOMMENDATIONS:

Adopt the attached resolution restricting parking of vehicles from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM on a portion of Main Street in the Piru area.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There is no fiscal impact associated with this Board letter.

DISCUSSION:

We have received complaints from residents living near the Fillmore-Piru Citrus plant on Main Street in Piru regarding trucks idling while parked on Main Street at night. The trucks are also equipped with refrigerator units which operate while the trucks are parked compounding the problem.

These complaints were first received by Mr. Mark Flippen, Plant Manager of Fillmore-Piru Citrus, and were then transmitted to the Public Works Agency via Supervisor Kildee's Office. We found that trucks routinely park along the west side of Main Street in front of the Fillmore-Piru Citrus plant waiting to make their deliveries to the plant or pick up loads for shipment.

Restricting the parking along the west side of Main Street in front of the Fillmore-Piru Citrus plant from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM will eliminate the noise generated by the trucks. The time restriction will continue to allow daytime on-street parking. Mr. Flippen has indicated that he concurs with the parking restriction.



The attached resolution conforms to the California Vehicle Code Section 22507 and is in a form previously approved by County Counsel for similar resolutions. Upon your approval, the Public Works Agency will erect regulatory signs.

**RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY OF VENTURA BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
RESTRICTING THE PARKING OF VEHICLES ON A PORTION
OF MAIN STREET**

WHEREAS, vehicles parking on the west side of Main Street adjacent to the Fillmore-Piru Citrus Plant create noise that is disruptive to the residents; and

WHEREAS, complaints have been received from residents living near the Fillmore-Piru Citrus Plant concerning vehicles parking on Main Street adjacent to the Plant causing noise during the night; and

WHEREAS, the California Vehicle Code, Section 22507, requires a resolution by local authorities to restrict the parking of vehicles between the hours of 10:00 PM and 6:00 AM.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF VENTURA COUNTY that upon placement of appropriate regulatory signs, vehicles will be prohibited from parking along the west side of Main Street beginning 75 feet north of the centerline of the intersection of Main Street and Via Fustero to a point 839 feet south of said beginning point, between the hours of 10:00 PM and 6:00 AM.

and duly carried, the foregoing resolution was approved on September 27,
1994.
