Discussion:

The Public Works Agency (PWA) seeks to engage the services of a consultant to update the Ventura County Waterworks District No. 1's 2008 Water Master Plan and 2015 UWMP (Project).

PWA identified six potential engineering consultants and invited them to submit Statements of Qualifications (SOQ) for the Project. Two SOQ's were received on September 16, 2019 and reviewed by a selection committee consisting of PWA staff. The two consultants were invited to oral interviews which were conducted on October 3, 2019. The committee selected Stantec as the most qualified firm for this Project.

PWA requests that the consultant services contract (Contract) with Stantec be approved by your Board.





The Contract with Stantec provides for updates to the 2008 Water Master Plan, and 2015 UWMP as outlined in Exhibit 1.

Payment for Stantec's services will be made based on fee schedule rates, but the total amount shall not exceed \$262,670 without modifying the Contract. The Contract was negotiated with Stantec in accordance with the policy adopted by your Board on November 3, 1998. The Contract is on a standard form previously reviewed by County Counsel.

This letter has been reviewed by the County Executive Office, the Auditor-Controller's Office, and County Counsel.
