Subject: Read aloud at the Meeting: comment on Agenda items #8, #9 -- we do not consent to COVID discrimination

We the people of Ventura County demand that this board pass a resolution opposing ANY program, protocol, guidance, or regulation that enables or requires proof of vaccination, and prohibits funding of any items relating to proof of vaccination.

While it's great that people are free to volunteer for EUA vaccine trials, it is very dangerous to create new infrastructure for people to disclose their medical information to engage in normal every-day activities outside of healthcare practice and HIPAA concerns.

It cannot be discounted as "voluntary" because it creates discrimination. A proof of vaccination system burdens private businesses, organizations, and governments with the liability of discriminating against people. This would be a violation of Equal Housing, Equal Employment, ADA, other Civil Rights laws, and our conscience. It is, in essence, a totalitarian social credit score with only a few missing parameters.

It cannot be discounted as "promoting safety" because it's based on lies and hate speech. The lie is that if you're vaccinated, you're safe. The clinical trials do NOT prove this. The hate speech is that if you don't get vaccinated, you are "selfish", and responsible for others dying. However, the contact tracing data show that healthy people with no symptoms do NOT spread COVID-19, and they DO contribute to herd immunity. Common sense says that people are responsible for their own immune systems, and can be trusted to make good decisions to avoid and recover from illness.
