To the Board of Supervisors,

At last week's meeting, a caller proposed that the Board of Supervisors pass a "vaccine resolution" to ensure that our citizens are protected against any form of so-called "vaccine passport" mandate. While the State government has publicly stated that there will be no 'vaccine passports", some companies - both private and public - have indicated an intention to institute such requirements. An official resolution, from the County Board of Supervisors, banning such illegal mandates would send a strong message to all businesses and citizens in Ventura County - that the rights guaranteed by both the State and Federal Constitutions will be protected. We are living in a time when our most important Rights - the 1st Amendment's Freedom of Speech and Assembly - are under attack.
