I'm afraid it wasn't clear. The reason many are concerned about Vaccine passports is that for the past year the board and sheriff have allowed businesses to violate the law and our civil rights. The CDPH mask guidance and the county mask order allows exemptions for medical conditions, yet you allow businesses to discriminate and violate Cal Civil Code 51B which states that all persons are entitled to the "Free and Equal" access to every business regardless of medical condition, disability, race etc. All businesses open to the public are by definition 'Public Accommodations' and as such must abide by ADA law and the Civil Rights Act. And now you are dancing around the issue of prohibiting businesses to discriminate based on vaccination status. You have spent the entire year telling businesses what they can and can't do so now is the time to tell them they must not make a two class society based on whether or not someone has submitted to this genetic experiment we call a vaccine, which is in the third phase of clinical trials. The people demand a resolution be passed by BOS to prohibit local businesses from requiring proof of vaccination.
