Discussion:

On February 9, 2021, the Board approved the submittal of a grant application to CalRecycle in the amount \$138,653. The Grant was approved by CalRecycle on April 7, 2021. The Grant will provide \$138,653 in RAC funding for the use of rubberized chip seal for the proposed streets shown in the list below and in Exhibit 1. The request for reimbursement, including a final report and payment requests, must be submitted to CalRecycle prior to April 1, 2023.
