**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF VENTURA COUNTY WATERWORKS DISTRICT
NO. 17 (BELL CANYON) CONTINUING EXISTING WATER STANDBY CHARGE
FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021-22**

WHEREAS, Ventura County Waterworks District No. 17 (District) provides water service to the community of Bell Canyon;

WHEREAS, under the authority of Water Code section 55501.5 and Government Code Section 54984, the District properly established a water standby charge for undeveloped properties for which water service is made available;

WHEREAS, District staff proposes to keep the current water standby charge unchanged for Fiscal Year 2021-22; and

WHEREAS, the District has submitted the attached report, Exhibit 1, showing a description of each parcel for which this standby charge is to be billed, together with the amount of the charge applicable to each parcel, so that said charges may be collected as a part of the annual general county tax bill;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board approves continuing the current water standby charge of \$46.82 per acre (or per parcel less than one acre), up to a maximum charge based on five (5) acres, as shown on Exhibit 1.

Upon motion of Board Member LaVere, seconded by Board Member Long, and duly carried, the Board of the District hereby approves and adopts this resolution on this 18th day of May, 2021.
