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Dear Board of Supervisors,

I am writing today to ask you to NOT approve this unethical agenda item. This "vaccine outreach" program would effectively coerce people into receiving a product that is essential still in the trial phase and has not received full FDA approval without disclosing the associated risks that people are entitled to know before making such an important decision.

The Vaccine Adverse Event Reporting System (VAERS) has reported a significant number of deaths and serious vaccine related injuries. As of 5/14/21 the system showed 192,954 reports of adverse events following COVID vaccines, including 4,057 deaths and 17,190 serious injuries between Dec 14, 2020 and May 7, 2021. Studies have shown that fewer than 1% of vaccine injuries are actually reported to VAERS as it is a passive and little known system.

The messaging on vaccines has systematically excluded vital information that people are entitled to in order to make health care decisions for themselves that could ultimately cost them their lives. For example, not a single county sponsored message on vaccines has included the fact that vaccine manufacturers are exempt from any liability from injuries or death caused by their vaccine. People are also not being told the fact that each and every covid vaccine on the market used aborted fetal cells at some point in their development, a fact that many would feel is important to know. Not to mention the significant risk from death or injury that it poses to the vaccine recipient when the virus itself would give most people immunity with less risk.

I urge the board to vote against this discriminatory, deceptive and unethical measure of coercion.
