Approval of, and Authorization for the Health Care Agency (HCA) Director or Designee to Execute, The First Amendment to the Agreement with the Trustees of the California State University for the Operation of the California State University Channel Islands Student Health Center, Effective July 1, 2021, Increasing the Maximum Amount to be Paid Under the Agreement to \$326,514; Ratification of HCA's Provision of Services Under the Terms of the Amendment in Anticipation of Your Board's Approval.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

- Approve, and authorize the Health Care Agency (HCA) Director or designee to sign, the first amendment to the agreement with the Trustees of the California State University for the operation of the California State University Channel Islands (CSUCI) Student Health Center, effective July 1, 2021, increasing the maximum amount to be paid under the agreement to \$326,514.
- 2. Ratify HCA's provision of services under the terms of the amendment in anticipation of your Boards' approval.

The increased revenue results from adjusting the hourly rates to align with the new HCA positions created for the CSUCI Student Health Center staff as a result of the Ambulatory Care Division's (AC) clinic integration project. The increase is the net difference between the new rates in the proposed amendment and the rates in the original agreement.

BACKGROUND:

Historically, AC operated the CSUCI Student Health Center, including administrative oversight of the staff and providers, as well as procurement of supplies and other materials, through a professional services and operations agreement with Health Center of Moorpark, a Medical Corporation. After the AC clinic integration, this operation has transitioned to AC, which now directly employs the CSUCI Student Health Center staff.

DISCUSSION:

The proposed amendment increases the hourly rates of the health center support staff and providers. The adjustment is in accordance with the A C clinic integration to ensure that the rates are aligned with the salaries and benefits of these staff and providers as HCA employees.
