## DISCUSSION:

VCHCP arranges for the provision of health care services, including prescription medication to members enrolled in its various benefit plans. Because of the complexity of issues involved in the administration of a medication benefit program, VCHCP, like most other health plans, utilizes an independent pharmacy benefit manager to manage its program. Under this agreement, ESI, on behalf of VCHCP, administers services which provide outpatient retail and mail-order prescription medication services to VCHCP members.

VCHCP is a full-service Knox-Keene licensed health plan regulated by the Department of Managed Health Care (DMHC). VCHCP is obligated to ensure contracted health care providers and vendors are compliant with the Knox-Keene Health Care Services Plan Act and applicable provisions of the California Health and Safety Code. The Amendment Number Eleven, presented to your Board today, is effective October 1, 2021 and adds regulatory compliance language into the ESI agreement. It also adds a delegation activity exhibit, which outlines activities VCHCP has delegated to ESI and VCHCP's responsibility of oversight of the delegated activities. After one year and a half of review and editing, the DMHC has approved this document. There is no fiscal impact associated with this amendment.
