<u>Subject</u>: Approval of, and Authorization for the Health Care Agency Director or Designee to Sign, the Fourth Amendment to the Agreement with Ventura County Orthopaedic Associates for Orthopedic Surgical Services, Extending the Term of the Agreement Through June 30, 2022, and Increasing the Contract Maximum to \$4,959,910 for Fiscal Year 2021-22.

Recommendation:

That your Board approve, and authorize the Health Care Agency Director or designee to sign, the fourth amendment to the agreement for orthopedic surgical services with Ventura County Orthopaedic Associates, extending the term of the agreement through June 30, 2022, and increasing the contract maximum by \$3,719,933 to \$4,959,910 for Fiscal Year 2021-22.

Discussion:

The proposed amendment before your Board is for Ventura County Orthopaedic Associates (VCOA). VCOA is a California partnership comprised of medical corporations operated by Drs. Emily Benson, Thomas Y. Wu, M.D., Denise Stennette, M.D., Damayea Hargett, M.D., Tadashi Takara, M.D., and Mary Ragsdale, M.D. In addition to these partners, the participating providers employed by VCOA are as follows: Michael Flynn Maguire, M.D., Inc. and Sean D. Early, M.D., Inc., operating through Pediatric Orthopedic & Scoliosis Center of Central Coast, a California partnership, Helena G. Keeter, PA-C, and Ross Monroe, PA-C.

The current agreement with VCOA expires on September 30, 2021. The amendment presented to your Board will renew existing terms and compensation in effect. The negotiations with VCOA will continue and a new agreement will be brought for approval to your Board when they are complete. The cost of this service is included in the current budget for Fiscal Year 2021-22.
