RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF VENTURA TO ESTABLISH A "NO PARKING ANY TIME" ZONE ON THE EAST SIDE OF OCEAN AVENUE, IN THE MUSSEL SHOALS AREA

WHEREAS, the County owns and maintains Ocean Avenue in the Mussel Shoals area;

WHEREAS, during periods of high surf, vehicles parked on Ocean Avenue create a safety hazard for residential traffic and restricts emergency vehicle access including by parking within an intersection (Veh. Code, § 22500(a)), in front of driveways (Veh. Code, § 22500(e)), and where the substandard shoulder width of the roadway are not sufficient to allow parking on both sides of the street;

WHEREAS, Ventura County Fire Department (VCFD) recognizes existing accessibility impediments which limits its ability to respond to emergency calls in the Mussel Shoals area due to vehicles parking on both sides of narrow roadways leaving limited clearances and impedes visibility all of which make emergency vehicle access extremely difficult;

WHEREAS, VCFD requests restricting on-street parking to one side of the roadway to allow suitable clear passage for residential traffic and emergency vehicle access;

WHEREAS, Public Works Agency Roads & Transportation (PWA-RT) evaluated the site inaccessibility and determined restricting on-street parking on the east side of Ocean Avenue due to the span, narrowness and several 90 degree turns along the roadway was feasible; and

WHEREAS, Vehicle Code section 22507 and Ventura County Ordinance Code section 7021 allow local authorities to impose parking restrictions by resolution;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that, under Vehicle Code section 22507 and Ventura County Ordinance Code section 7021, effective immediately upon placement of appropriate parking signs or markings, it shall be unlawful for any person to park any vehicle in the following location, at any time:

On the east side of Ocean Avenue from Old PCH	to Breakers Way.
