

RESOLUTION NO. 21-137

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF VENTURA TO ESTABLISH "NO PARKING ANY TIME" ZONES AT VARIOUS INTERSECTIONS ALONG EL ROBLAR DRIVE AND FERNANDO DRIVE, IN THE MEINERS OAKS AREA**

**WHEREAS**, the County owns and maintains El Roblar Drive and Fernando Drive in the Meiners Oaks area;

**WHEREAS**, a study of existing vehicular, pedestrian, and bicycle traffic along El Roblar Drive and other streets in the Meiners Oaks area was completed and recommendations to improve roadway and intersection safety included narrow travel lanes, adding edge lines, installing high visibility crosswalks, and establishing no-parking zones;

**WHEREAS**, Public Works Agency Roads & Transportation (PWA-RT) evaluated the study and determined to proceed with installing high visibility crosswalks and establishing no-parking zones at this time to enhance corner sight visibility at various intersections along El Roblar Drive and Fernando Drive;

**WHEREAS**, Vehicle Code section 22507 and Ventura County Ordinance Code section 7021 allow local authorities to impose parking restrictions by resolution; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that, under Vehicle Code section 22507 and Ventura County Ordinance Code section 7021, effective immediately upon placement of appropriate markings, it shall be unlawful for any person to park any vehicle in the following location, at any time:

- On Pueblo Avenue, from the intersection with El Roblar Drive, south 10 feet, on both the east and west sides
- On El Roblar Drive, from the intersection with Pueblo Avenue, east 10 feet, on the south side only
- On Fernando Drive, from the intersection with Arnaz Street, east 20 feet on both the north and south sides, and west 20 feet, on both the north and south sides
- On Fernando Drive, from the intersection with Alvarado Street, east 20 feet on both the north and south sides, and west 20 feet, on both the north and south sides

- On Fernando Drive, from the intersection with Padre Juan Avenue, east 20 feet on both the north and south sides, and west 20 feet, on both the north and south sides

Upon motion of Supervisor Ramirez, seconded by Supervisor Long, and duly carried, the Board hereby approves and adopts this resolution on this 12<sup>th</sup> day of October 2021.
