Dear Members of the Board:

Once I learned that Supervisor Kelly Long can serve out her term in office, and after reviewing the posted 5 draft alternative maps, and while I cannot decide to date which particular district draft alternative map to choose, I wholeheartedly support keeping cities intact:

#1 - The City of Moorpark must not be split! #2 - The City of Thousand Oaks must not be split! #3 - The City of Camarillo must not be split!

The Moorpark Acorn on October 29, 2021 had 3 letters from Moorpark residents concerning evacuation routes in this part of the County! If the traffic flowing on the 101 toward Camarillo has to be redirected onto the 23 because of some incident, the drivers have to go through the City of Moorpark to use Santa Rosa Road or E. Los Angeles Avenue (118) to reach their destinations in Camarillo, Somis, Oxnard, Ventura, Port Hueneme, Santa Paula, Bardsdale, Fillmore, Piru, Saticoy, Ojai, Meiner Oaks, etc.! Members of the Board, I am very grateful to Supervisor Kelly Long for allowing me to work with her staff in order to help the County's 3 public cemetery districts(2 in the 3rd Supervisor District, and 1 in the 4th Supervisor District) in order to preserve their historical cemeteries (Bardsdale Cemetery, Piru Cemetery, and El Rancho Simi Pioneer Cemetery) for future generations! My hope and prayer is that the next Supervisor who represents the redistricted area keeps the momentum gained through the efforts of Supervisor Long, her staff, and the Board of Trustees of the Bardsdale Cemetery District, and the Board of Trustees of the Piru Public Cemetery District going!
