Hello,

As a resident of Oak Park, I would like to respectfully urge the Ventura County Board of Supervisors to please vote 'Yes' on District R or Map 2a, and 'No' to 1A or Lulac map or community plan map.

Oak Park is a community that is very different and distant from Simi Valley. Our community is shared in a much more physically meaningful way with residents in Thousand Oaks as we are closer together, share more communities/schools/parks/malls, etc. and also share many of the same city support structures. We believe it makes little sense to lump Oak Park with Simi Valley together on a map, as it is physically distant with significant miles of mountainous terrain separating us. (Distances makes it very difficult to even visit Simi Valley and vice versa). Please consider the practicalities of such a situation and allow Oak Park to remain part of Thousand Oaks.
