


COVID-19 Report Board of Supervisors November 9, 2021



County of Ventura COVID-19 Information

- Positivity rate (2.2%), case rate (9.5) and hospital rate (33) continue to remain flat after previously trending downwards (was 2.3, 9.5, 34 @ last report)
- Ventura County continues to have one of the highest vaccination rates in the state and nation
- Now over 83.2% of county residents 18+ have received at least 1 dose and 75.7% 12+ fully vaccinated
- Statewide 81.4% have received at least one dose.
- 93.6% of residents 65+ have received at least one dose
- Over 1,187,583 vaccines administered in county (1st,2nd dose & boosters)
 - 71,329 vaccines since October 19th (~ 23,776 per week).
- \$90M+ in rental assistance applications open www.HousinglsKey.com
 - 11,000 applications submitted, \$134.8M in assistance applied for (was 9,975/\$115.5M last report)
- \$71.9M in business assistance made available
 - 6,943 businesses have received assistance. 1,201 payments mailed this week.


Flu and COVID PODs

 - o 87 flu doses, 36 COVID doses



COVID Vaccine for Children

- Final approval 6 days ago by Western States Scientific Review Workgroup
- Vaccination of children 5 to 11 years of age in full swing
- Pediatrician vaccinated 170 to 200 children last Thursday and Friday
- No anticipated vaccine shortages
- Reactions mild, self-limited, less than older children and adults
- Efficacy 90.7% against symptomatic disease


Public Health Officer Update

Why Vaccinate Children 5 to 11 Years of Age?

- To protect them: 9,000 hospitalizations and 680 deaths
- Ten percent will get long COVID
- Transmit to others
- Can visit grandparents
- Miss less school and see fewer school closures
- May play sports
- May travel with parents
- Reduce size of susceptible population which:
 - decreases opportunity for new variants
 - decreases chances of surges that close schools and businesses
