

RESOLUTION NO. 21-153

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF VENTURA
AUTHORIZING THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY TO ACCEPT FUNDING FOR THE
AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE FRAUD PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the Ventura County District Attorney's Office desires to continue the project designated as the Automobile Insurance Fraud Program to be funded in part from the funds made available through the California Insurance Code section 1872.8, and California Code of Regulations, Title 10, Section 2698.60 et seq. and administered by the California Department of Insurance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the District Attorney of the County of Ventura is authorized to apply for and accept state funds for the Automobile Insurance Fraud Program in the amount of \$330,202 from the California Department of Insurance; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the District Attorney is authorized to execute the Grant Award Agreement including any extensions or amendments thereof, subject to the review and approval of County Counsel; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that it is agreed that any liability arising out of the performance of the Grant Award Agreement, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grant recipient and the authorizing agency. The State of California and the California Department of Insurance disclaim responsibility for any such liability; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by the Board of Supervisors.

On motion of Supervisor LaYere, seconded by Supervisor Huber, the foregoing resolution was passed and adopted on this 9th day of November, 2021.
