RESOLUTION OF VACATION
OF
A PORTION RIO SCHOOL LANE

WHEREAS, on October 19, 2021, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Ventura, State of California adopted a Notice and Resolution of Intention to Vacate a Portion of Rio School Lane;

WHEREAS, a hearing was set for November 9, 2021, and notice of the hearing was given for the time and in the manner prescribed by law;

WHEREAS, the hearing was held and evidence submitted to the Board of Supervisors, bearing upon the present and prospective use of the County highway for public use;

WHEREAS, the developer of the Rio Urbana residential development has agreed to grant a non-exclusive access easement to any abutting property owner upon request, with said easement being recorded prior to or concurrently with this resolution; and

WHEREAS, based on the evidence submitted, the Board of Supervisors hereby approves the FINDINGS set forth on Exhibit "C," which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Ventura finds, resolves, and orders that the portion of the County highway described in Exhibit "A" and illustrated on Exhibit "B," which exhibits are attached hereto and incorporated herein by these references, is not necessary for present or prospective public use and is hereby vacated.

Upon motion of Supervisor Ramirez, seconded by Supervisor Long, and duly carried, the Board hereby approves and adopts this resolution on the 9 day of November 2021.

(3 MR 26)

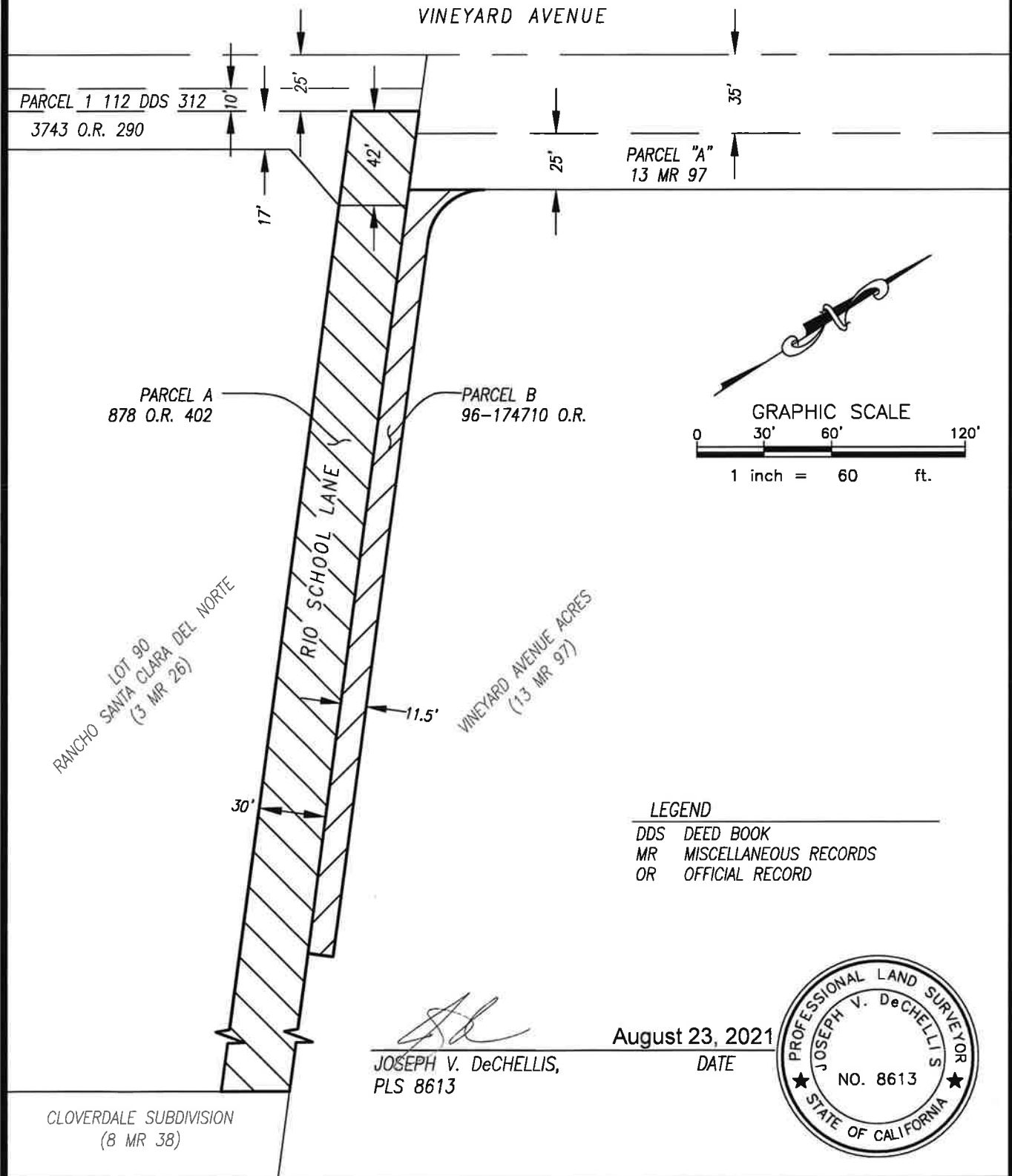


EXHIBIT C

STATEMENT OF FINDINGS FOR VACATION OF RIO SCHOOL LANE

- The proposal of vacation has been reviewed by the Planning Department, as prescribed, Section 65402 of the Government Code, and was found to be consistent with the Ventura County General Plan Facilities Map and applicable General Plan goals and policies.
- The right-of-way to be vacated is a public street or highway within the meaning of Section 8308 of the Streets and Highway Code.
- The vacation will serve a public purpose as the County's liability and maintenance obligations will be reduced.
- The right-of-way to be vacated is not useful as a non-motorized transportation facility.
- The right-of-way to be vacated is not necessary for present or prospective public use.
- The proposed vacation has been reviewed and approved by the Ventura County Fire Department.
