## Dear Members of the Board:

Lunderstand that you will be discussing the above Ordinance at your August 4, 2009 Board Meeting. Although I cannot be at the meeting, I would like to make an urgent appeal to you to approve this Urgency Ordinance.

In the twenty years since clean up of SSFL began, there have been many mis-steps and outright errors made by Rocket dyne, that have been a great cause of concern. I am confident that Ventura County will do all they can to protect the health of their constituents by passing this Grading Permit Urgency Ordinance before you at the August 4, 2009 meeting.
