I am writing to express my strong support for Supervisor Parks' motion regarding the grading permit for soil removal at Outfalls 8 and 9 of the Santa Susana Field Lab property.

Allowing the Boeing Co. to remove soil without a discretionary permit and the proper environmental review, thus shutting out the public from the process, is not acceptable. The communities affected by what happened at the Santa Susana Field Lab were left in the dark for decades. Even today, it takes dogged persistence by activists and legislators to make sure the cleanup process is done in the light of day. A discretionary permit is the proper way to keep the public informed on this project.
