RESOLUTION OF THE  
VENTURA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
REGARDING THE  
JUVENILE ACCOUNTABILITY BLOCK GRANT APPLICATION

WHEREAS the County of Ventura desires to receive and utilize federal grant funds available through the Juvenile Accountability Block Grants (JABG) Program administered by the Corrections Standards Authority (hereafter referred to as CSA).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Chief Probation Officer of the Ventura County Probation Agency is authorized on behalf of the Board of Supervisors to submit the JABG application and sign the Grant Contract with the CSA, including any amendments thereof.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County of Ventura agrees to provide all matching funds required for said project, and abide by the statutes and regulations governing the JABG Program as well as the terms and conditions of the Grant Contract as set forth by the CSA.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.
