Sufficient appropriations are available in the Liability & General Insurance Internal Service Fund (Org 7010) to accommodate this request.

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Discussion:

Master Service Agreements set the price and other conditions for specific services. Approving the service agreement does not generate any actual expenditure. Expenditures occur as services are procured and rendered.

On July 28, 2009, the Board authorized the County Purchasing agent to set the combined total amount for attorney firms representing the County in litigation through the CEO-Risk Management Department at an amount not to exceed \$4,500,000. The request herein does not seek to alter the combined total, but rather to add a firm that may be compensated from within that total.

During the current fiscal year, in connection with, and with the approval of County Counsel, Risk Management added the law firm of Epstein, Turner & Song to its panel of defense firms to represent the County during litigation. This firm has expertise in the defense of employment actions.

The firm has been assigned the defense of three actions. It is anticipated that fees and costs related to these actions combined will exceed \$100,000 before the end of the current fiscal year. It is requested that the Board authorize amendment to the Master Service Agreement with this law firm to permit services provided this fiscal year not to exceed \$250,000.
