Discussion:

The Regional Catastrophic Preparedness Grant Program (RCPGP) is intended to enhance regional catastrophic preparedness efforts, with the aim of strengthening the Nation against risks associated with catastrophic events. The RCPGP centers on the highest risk Urban Areas and surrounding regions, where its impact will have the most significant effect on our collective security and resilience. The County of Ventura has been allocated \$80,000 in FY 2010 RCPGP funds by the Los Angeles Urban Area. These funds will be used to offset the cost of implementing regional disaster recovery projects. Since we are so close to the end of the fiscal year, we will not be budgeting appropriations until next fiscal year.

The performance period for the grant began August 1, 2010; however, it has taken the City of Los Angeles over 18 months to develop the grant contract and provide it to us. The performance period ends March 31, 2013. Matching funds will be "in-kind" and be provided by existing OES staff.
