As VMF Board members, County residents, festival-goers and other supporters we ask the Board of Supervisors to create a "Relief and Recovery Fund for the Arts" with 5% of its ARPA funding. While the Art sector's economic impact in the County matches Agriculture's, the pandemic laid bare the particular vulnerability of the arts ecosystem, beset historically by little to no government support or corporate funding, and limited foundation grants. Covid's hit on the sector, especially performing arts, has been devastating. VMF alone sustained 50% losses in income. The American Recovery Act itself lists Arts and Culture high among priority sectors to be funded, and indeed, it is already an express area of interest for the Board of Supervisors.

Besides helping to drive and build the economy, the petitioners value greatly the impacts of music and the arts on many other things: like youth academic achievement, mental health, emotional intelligence, the human spirit, community-building. As for VMF's place in the County, we are considered one of its prominent music resources along with Ojai Music Festival and New West Symphony. Founded 27 years ago in response to a City of Ventura survey calling for a signature cultural event, our mission is to build community through live, diverse world-class music. This year, 3,300 Ventura County residents attended the eight live VMF concerts presented thus far. To assure cost was not a barrier, we underwrote fees for students and financially-challenged others (a third of the audience). A mixed-genre music program means that festival-goers will see and hear themselves reflected in the music.

As to ultimate funding guidelines and allocations, we respectfully suggest a broad and equitable distribution plan that ensures a relationship between the amount granted and: organizational history (service years); number of attendees/participants; economic impact; budget size; professional quality of product.

Time and again, we have witnessed shared attendance at live music performances and other arts events bringing people together in palpable celebrations of joy and community. We ask the Board to invest in the recovery of the Ventura County arts sector so that it can go forward enriching lives and communities in countless diverse and creative ways. At this historic moment, you have an opportunity to affect positive outcomes and lead development of a robust arts infrastructure in our county. Please do so.
