Why a Master Plan

- Population of County is older with more than 25% of people over 60 years of age
- Builds bridges across County departments many of whom have policies that impact older adults and people with disabilities - to support cross sector planning and implementation
- Incorporates an aging and disabilities lens across county priorities beyond the traditional health care and community-based services
- Raises awareness about how aging and disability related policies impacts people at all stages of life.

- Good ideas that didn't make the final plan added so that non-profits or cities can work on them if they choose



5 Goals

- Goal 1 Housing for All Ages and Stages We will live where we choose as we age in communities that are age, disability, and dementia friendly and disaster ready
- Goal 2 Health Reimagined We will have access to the services we need to live at home in our communities and to optimize our health and quality of life
- Goal 3 Inclusion and Equity, Not Isolation We will have lifelong opportunities for work,
 volunteering, engagement, and leadership and
 will be protected from isolation,
 discrimination, abuse, neglect, and
 exploitation
- Goal 4 Caregiving that Works We will be prepared for and supported through the rewards and challenges of caring for aging loved ones.
- Goal 5 Affordable Aging We will have economic security for as long as we live
