RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF VENTURA
ESTABLISHING TWO FIXED-TERM POSITIONS IN THE VENTURA COUNTY
DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE

WHEREAS, Ventura County Personnel Rules and Regulations sections 903 and 2701 provide that the number of County positions must be established by resolution of the Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, the Ventura County District Attorney's Office has been awarded the Family Justice Center Program (Ventura location) and increased funding; and

WHEREAS, the Ventura County District Attorney's Office has identified and requested the establishment of fixed-term positions for Victim Advocate II and Legal Processing Assistant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF VENTURA that the following fixed-term positions shall be established within the District Attorney's Office, effective October 11, 2022, through March 31, 2024:
