Exhibit B Disclosure Categories

Subject to the definitions set forth in the Political Reform Act and applicable regulations:

Category 1 - BROADEST DISCLOSURE

- (1) All sources of income including gifts, loans and travel payments;
- (2) All interests in real property; and
- (3) All investments and business positions in business entities.

Category 2 - REAL PROPERTY

All interests in real property.

Category 3 – LAND DEVELOPMENT AND TRANSACTION

All investments, business positions and income including gifts, loans and travel payments, from sources of the type which engage in land development, construction, or acquisition or sale of real property.

Category 4 – PROCUREMENT

All investments, business positions and income including gifts, loans and travel payments, from sources of the type which provide services, facilities, supplies, materials, machinery or equipment of the type utilized by the District.

Category 5 – REGULATION AND PERMITTING

All investments, business positions and income including gifts, loans and travel payments, from sources of the type which are subject to the regulatory, permitting or licensing authority of, or have an application or license pending before the District.

Category 6 – FUNDING

All investments, business positions and income including gifts, loans and travel payments, from sources of the type which receive grants or other monies from or through the District.
