**GRANT AGREEMENT NUMBER 22-10844**

The Department awards this Grant and the Grantee accepts and agrees to use the Grant funds as follows:

**AUTHORITY:** The Department has authority to grant funds for the Project under Health and Safety Code Section 131085(a).

**PURPOSE:** The Department shall award this Grant Agreement to and for the benefit of the Grantee; the purpose of the Grant is to implement public health activities to monitor, investigate, and prevent sexually transmitted diseases (STD) in collaboration with community-based organizations (CBOs), or nonprofit health care providers within the local health jurisdiction (LHJ). Funds allocated to the LHJs shall be used for innovative and impactful STD prevention and control activities including, but not limited to, the following: voluntary screening for STDs among inmates and wards of county adult and juvenile correctional facilities; technology, telehealth, and digital platforms and applications to enhance immediate access to screening, testing, and treatment; state-of-the-art testing modalities that ensure swift and accurate screening for and diagnosis of STDs; community-based testing and disease investigation; integrated services for STIs, viral hepatitis, human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) infection, and drug overdose, to the extent they improve health outcomes; and material support including, but not limited to sleeping bags, tarps, shelter, clothing items, and hygiene kits, to people living with, or at risk for, STIs. Key strategic targets for STD prevention and control are: enhancement of surveillance and case follow up for syphilis cases; testing, treatment, partner services, and referrals to services for vulnerable and underserved clients at high risk for STDs; and implementation of community-based services through partnerships between LHJs, CBOs and nonprofit health care providers.

**GRANT AMOUNT:** The maximum amount payable under this Grant Agreement shall not exceed the amount of \$754,390.

**TERM OF GRANT AGREEMENT:** The term of the Grant shall begin on July 1, 2022 and terminate on June 30, 2024. No funds may be requested or invoiced for services performed or costs incurred after June 30, 2024.
