Discussion:

The Medi-Cal Administered Activities (MAA) program offers a way for local governmental agencies (LGA) to obtain federal reimbursement for the cost of certain activities necessary for the proper and efficient administration of the Medi-Cal program. The County of Ventura entered into an agreement with the State to provide MAA as an effective method of assuring the availability and accessibility of Medi-Cal services to Medi-Cal eligible individuals. VCPH acts as the LGA representative for the MAA program in Ventura County.

As required by the contract with the State, VCPH submitted a comprehensive claiming plan to DHCS describing in detail the provision of services to be claimed. DHCS approved their participation in the program in January 2021. The MOA presented to your Board for approval today delineates the responsibilities of F5VC as a provider of services and VCPH as the administrator of claims processing to the State for this program, beginning January 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024. The services provided by F5VC, with your Board's approval, will include those which are within the MAA allowable categories of Medi-Cal Outreach, Referral and Monitoring of Medi-Cal Services, and Program and Planning Development of Medi-Cal Services. VCPH first brought this agreement to your Board for approval in 2021 and is recommending renewal of the MOA effective January 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024.
