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VCCIE Project Objectives



Ventura County is seeking to implement a cross-sector community information exchange (CIE) to advance the coordination of medical, behavioral, and social services across the community



Establishing a data collection approach to gather information on CIE technology needs among key community partners



Supporting the development of detailed business and technical requirements for the selected approach to technology functionality to be included in a future VCCIE technology procurement process

California Advancing & Innovating Medi-Cal (CalAIM)


- A long-term commitment to transform & strengthen Medi-Cal to provide a more equitable, coordinated, and person-centered approach to improve health outcomes
- Builds capacity of infrastructure by partnering with community-based organizations (CBOs), public hospitals, & county agencies for care coordination
- Focuses on population health, enhanced care management, community supports, and data exchange framework
- Ventura County Health Care Agency obtained approval to enter into data exchange agreement on 1/10/23. Most providers required to begin data exchange by 1/31/24
