SUBJECT: Authorization for the Ventura County Behavioral Health Director to Amend Temporary Staffing and Recruiting Services Agreements with Maxim Healthcare, Medix Staff Solutions, and TheKey of California to Increase Their Combined Maximum Contract Amount from \$1,300,000 to \$2,250,000 (an increase of \$950,000), Effective July 1, 2022 Through June 30, 2023.

RECOMMENDATION:

Authorization for the Ventura County Behavioral Health (VCBH) Director or designee to execute amendments to the agreements with Maxim Healthcare, Medix Staff Solutions, and TheKey of California for the provision of temporary staffing and recruiting services to increase their combined maximum contract amounts from \$1,300,000 to \$2,250,000 (an increase of \$950,000), effective July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023, subject to County Counsel review and approval as to form.

DISCUSSION:

On June 21, 2022, your Board approved three (3) agreements for medical personnel temporary staffing and recruiting services with Maxim Healthcare Services Holdings, Inc. (Maxim), Medix Staffing Solutions, Inc. (Medix), and TheKey of California, LLC for a combined maximum contract amount of \$1,300,000. VCBH is requesting authorization for an additional increase of \$950,000 for a revised combined contract maximum amount of \$2,250,000 to address current VCBH staffing vacancies and ensure continued service provision to meet the needs of the consumers served by VCBH through the end of FY 2022-23 (June 30, 2023). Currently, the VCBH staffing vacancy rate is 26.1%. These contractors have proven to be a vital source of staffing services during the ongoing staffing shortage.
