- Formed on April 11, 1977
- The Ventura County Board of Supervisors (BOS) is the Board of Directors for District 17.
- The Citizens' Advisory Committee reviews all policy, budget, and water rate recommendations before they are recommended to the BOS.

Area Served: Bell Canyon & the Contiguous Areas to the North

District Size: Approx. 4,900 Acres

Population Served: Approx. 2,049

Water Lines: ~17.5 Miles

Service Connections: 714

Receives 100% Imported Water Supply






Rate Model Assumptions for 2023

- Calleguas Municipal Water District Approved Rate increase of 4.5% for 2023
- Assumes water use reduction of 30% through FY 2024
- Assumed inflationary increases used for rate analysis:
 - Labor 3.5%, Electricity 4%, and materials 3%
- 1.5 MG Reservoir and Saddlebow Pipeline projects will be financed by 0% interest State Revolving Fund Loan with 30% Principal forgiveness
 - Project creates system redundancy for fire protection
 - Construction targeted to begin in FY 2025
- Repair and Recoating of Reservoir #1 Planned for FY 2024 (funded from reserves)
- PROPOSED Rate increase is 5% for commodity and fixed charges for 2023




Calleguas vs. WWD#17 Historic Rate Increases 2011-2022
