Dear Supervisors

In honor of Beloved Carmen Ramirez, I urge you to deny approval for new oil wells near schools and homes.

We know that Air pollution represents an everyday health threat for those communities in close proximity to oil and gas. We should be eliminating standing wells, not adding to them. Particularly those in Environmental Justice neighborhoods because failing to protect such disadvantaged communities is racism, plain and simple.

Oxnard communities should not bear the burden of any more pollution and environmental racism. The communities impacted by these wells already experience a pollution burden 77-93% higher than other California communities; higher than any other community in Ventura County. These are communities of color (over 90% Latinx and Asian) that experiencing poverty at rates 64-90% higher than the rest of the state. This expansion of polluting and dangerous fossil fuel infrastructure would not be happening in your neighborhood or adjacent to your Children's schools. It should not happen here.

Vote with your conscience, vote with your heart. Protect the children of Lemonwood. It is the right thing to do.
