

RESOLUTION NO. 23-018

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE
VENTURA COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT
ACKNOWLEDGING RECEIPT OF THE 2022 ANNUAL
INSPECTION REPORT OF CERTAIN OCCUPANCIES
PURSUANT TO SECTION 13146.4 OF THE CALIFORNIA
HEALTH AND SAFETY CODE**

WHEREAS, California Health and Safety Code (Health and Safety Code) section 13146.4 was added in 2018 and became effective on September 27, 2018; and,

WHEREAS, Health and Safety Code sections 13146.2 and 13146.3 require all fire departments or districts that provide fire protection services, including the Ventura County Fire Protection District (Fire District), to annually inspect every building used as a public or private school (kindergarten through twelfth grade), hotels, motels, lodging houses, apartments/condominiums, and certain residential care facilities for compliance with regulations and building standards adopted by the State Fire Marshal; and

WHEREAS, Health and Safety Code section 13146.4 requires all fire departments or districts that provide fire protection services, including the Fire District, to report annually to its administering authority on its compliance with Health and Safety Code sections 13146.2 and 13146.3; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Fire District intends this Resolution to fulfill the requirements of Health and Safety Code section 13146.4 by acknowledging receipt of the Fire District's 2022 report and compliance with the annual inspections required of Health and Safety Code Sections 13146.2 and 13146.3.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Ventura County Fire Protection District Board of Directors hereby expressly acknowledges receipt of the Fire District's report and measure of compliance with Health and Safety Code sections 13146.2 and 13146.3 in the area encompassed by the County of Ventura, as follows:

1. **EDUCATIONAL GROUP E OCCUPANCIES:**
 - A. Description – Group E occupancies are generally public and private schools used by more than six persons at any one time for educational purposes, consisting of kindergarten through the twelfth grade. Within the County of Ventura, there are 309 known Group E occupancies.

- B. Compliance – During calendar year 2022, the Fire District completed the annual inspection of all 309 Group E occupancies. This is a compliance rate of 100 percent for this reporting period.


2. RESIDENTIAL GROUP R OCCUPANCIES:

- A. Description – Group R occupancies are generally those occupancies containing sleeping units, which include hotels, motels, and apartments (three units or more), as well as other residential occupancies, including a number of residential care facilities. These residential care facilities have a number of different sub-classifications and may contain residents or clients that have a range of needs, including those related to custodial care, mobility impairments, and cognitive disabilities. The residents may also be non-ambulatory or bedridden. Within the County of Ventura, there are 928 known Group R occupancies (and their associated sub-categories) of this nature.
- B. Compliance – During calendar year 2022, the Fire District completed the annual inspection of all 928 Group R occupancies. This is a compliance rate of 100 percent for this reporting period.
