NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Public Hearing will be held, as provided by law, by the Board of Supervisors of Ventura County on February 28, 2023, in the Board of Supervisors Hearing Room, Hall of Administration, 800 South Victoria Avenue, Ventura, California, to consider and decide the following matter: The Board of Supervisors will consider entering into Energy Service Contracts with Swell Services, Inc, for the installation of a Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) at Fire Station 42, 295 East High Street in Moorpark, California and at Fire Station 43, 5874 East Los Angeles Avenue in Simi Valley, California. The project is estimated to save the County \$6,600 per year. The batteries will be installed to be low profile and connect to the existing electrical system at the stations, with minimal impact on the operation of the stations. The public hearing is pursuant to Government Code section 4217.12 which requires a public hearing to consider a resolution to adopt findings regarding anticipated energy cost savings and other benefits the County may receive if the Board of Supervisors decides to enter into the energy service contracts.
