**Whereas,** Cadet Colonel Hiral Choudhary was born on June 3rd in the City of Oxnard, she has a younger sister and a younger brother; and

**Whereas,** Cadet Colonel Choudhary attended Atherwood and Vista Elementary Schools in Simi Valley, Bridges Charter School in Thousand Oaks and is currently a Senior at Royal High School in Simi Valley; and

**Whereas,** Cadet Colonel Choudhary's parents immigrated to the United States from India in 2001 and her father started in the Information Technology business and now works as a Field Operations Manager for Amgen, and her mother graduated from Loma Linda University and is currently a Family Physician at Sierra Vista Medical Clinic in the City of Simi Valley; and

**Whereas,** in August of 2019 Hiral Choudhary joined the Air Force Junior Reserve Officers' Training Corps (JROTC) program at the start of her freshman year at Royal High School, and in January 2023 of her Senior year she was able to achieve the rank of Cadet Colonel; and

**Whereas,** In the summer before Cadet Colonel Choudhary's Senior year she was able to attend Purdue University to attend the Flight Academy Program as part of the Chief of Staff Private Pilot Scholarship Program and obtain her private pilot license. The Chief of Staff Private Pilot Scholarship program was awarded to 150 JROTC Students nationwide and Cadet Colonel Hiral Choudhary and Cadet Lieutenant Colonel William Torres, both Seniors at Royal High School were chosen to participate; and

**Whereas,** Cadet Colonel Choudhary is also the Team Manager for the Royal High School Lacrosse Team and is an avid creator of photography and cinematography with some of her work being published in magazines; and

**Whereas,** After graduation Cadet Colonel Choudhary will be attending Purdue University to study Engineering and Professional Flight, she will continue her work with the Air Force ROTC Program as well with hopes to commission as a Second Lieutenant in the United States Air Force; and

**Whereas,** Cadet Colonel Choudhary says that her favorite part of the JROTC program is the family of cadets that work together and always push each other out of their comfort zones and help each other to build memories through their various activities that will carry them beyond their high school years; and

**Whereas,** Cadet Colonel Choudhary is very thankful for the guidance she has received from Master Sergeant Johnson of the Air Force JROTC Program and she wants to thank him for his unconditional support of her dreams both big and small and for becoming more than just an instructor from school, but a life changing mentor.
