**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF VENTURA
AUTHORIZING THE VENTURA COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE'S APPLICATION TO THE
STATE OF CALIFORNIA, DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION OFF-
HIGHWAY VEHICLE GRANT FUND**

WHEREAS, the Ventura County Sheriff's Office desires to apply for grant funding through the Off-Highway Vehicle Grant Program of the State of California, Department of Parks and Recreation, for the award period of October 1, 2023 through September 30, 2024 and intends to use the funds from the grant, if awarded, to compensate for off-highway vehicle patrol overtime, training, equipment, and off-highway vehicle-specific community based educational and safety programs; and

WHEREAS, as part of the application, the State of California requires, among other things, a resolution of an applicant's governing body that the applicant is authorized to apply for the grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Ventura County Sheriff's Office is authorized to submit a grant application to the State of California, Department of Parks and Recreation, for Off-Highway Vehicle Grant Funds for the award period of October 1, 2023 through September 30, 2024.
