Mesa advocates for innovative upstream approaches to preventing youth homelessness. This is accomplished through a holistic approach to the individual, the building of strong relationships within the community, and the therapeutic potential of regenerative agriculture.

FACT: When you experience homelessness or housing insecurity as a kid, your chances of living a stable life as an adult largely vanish.

- 3,600 youth will age out of foster care in California in 2022
- Over **50%** of those who age out of the foster system experience homelessness within 2 years.
- And, without intervention, 22% of those young people will see their own children enter the same broken system---a multi-generational issue that MUST change.



Instilling and Restoring Resilience & Inner Strength

We are moving upstream from the symptoms of homelessness, incarceration and dependence on social programs to intervene during a critical crossroads - the transition toward an adulthood characterized by **resilience** and **strength** through **relationship**.
