Project ID 7: Assessment of Land Near Electrical Transmission and Distribution Lines

• Why Important

- 1. Creation of Renewable Energy Priority Zone, if needed
- If none, there will be less renewable energy (COS8.5), no green economy (EV 4.2), no green construction (EV 6.3) and future jobs of next 20 years (EV 6.7)
- 3. To Allow for the development of facilities **<u>and</u>** approaches to renewable energy
- 4. To allow for the potential of developing local green industries and businesses
- What should be the input consideration
 - 1. What would be the future demand (including Ventura County) electrified transportation, building and homes (COS 8.5 and 8.10)
 - 2. What is our existing <u>and</u> future grid infrastructure from SCE (lines & substations)
 - 3. What would be our vision for (local & exported) energy mixture **and** industry
 - 4. Disadvantaged Community and Federal/State/County Investment Money

Project ID: 7 (cont'd)

- What do I expect from the outcome
 - 1. Identification of locations for development of renewable energy (EV 4.3)
 - 2. If more than a few, designate/standardize a Priority Zone (COS-O)
 - 3. Foundation & Flexibility to Support Green Industries and Businesses (EV 4.2, 5.1 and 5.2, COS 8.10)
 - 4. Implement Smart Grid (PFS 7.6) and Community Microgrid (LU 16, PFS 7.7) for better scalability and resilience (EV 5.2)
 - 5. Their relations to Disadvantaged Community
- Vehicle to work with SCE
 - 1. Preferred Partnership and Supplier
 - 2. Opportunity to Collaborate for enhanced transmission & distribution lines
 - 3. Work with Alternatives, e.g. CPA, CCA (Community Choice Aggregator)

Project ID 48: Update Non-Coastal Zoning Ordinance for Alternative Fuel Productions

- Project Work: Oct 2023 to Nov 2024 (PC in Dec 2024, BOS in Mar 2025)
- LU-E = LU 11.9
 - The County shall allow the production of alternative energy <u>and</u> alternative fuels on land <u>within the Industrial designation</u> to reduce the reliance on petroleum-based fuel and greenhouse gas emissions.
- May <u>exclude</u> certain technologies
 - Bidirectional EV Charging (may come from Commercial and Residential Zone*)
 - Produce Hydrogen from Sea Water
 - Use Wind Energy and/or Wave Energy to produce electricity (EV 4.2, 4.4)
- Advice Should not be too restrictive to limit ourselves

 - Project ID 16: Interagency Coordination for Implementation of General Plan Programs (COS-AA, EV-B) – July 2023 to June 2024
 - July 2023 to December 2023
 - Ongoing afterwards
- More Funding for Disadvantaged Community
 - Exclusive Rebates for DAC & LIC sites (launched in 2023) (LCFS Credit)
 - \$30m (150kW+): Upto 50% of total project costs with upto \$100,000 per Active Connector
 - Level 2: base incentive (upto \$3500 or 75%), multi-family (+\$3500), tribal (+\$3500)
 - Expiring June 2nd, 2023 (2021 + 2 years)
 - \$12m for 3 counties (50%+ reserved for DAC & LIC in Ventura County)
 - Level 2 (+\$500), 55~99kW (+\$10,000 or 75%), 100kW (+\$20,000 or 75%)
 - Alternative Fuel Infrastructure Federal Tax Credit (Commercial)
